

Author Predicts Australia on the Road to Anarchy



It might be a piece of fiction, but *Garcia's Smoking House* based on current events, highlights how the lack of real democracy and too many social laws leads to a revolution in Australia. But those in control, such as Commander Alan Draper, head of the Anti-Terrorist Squad, and Government Minister William Tolfer, have the means to eliminate anyone who threatens the balance of power. As they implement the Smoking House Law, one that will mean further oppression, violence escalates, building to total chaos. Draper and Tolfer possess 'green' secrets,' but with the power of government behind them, are determined to keep the secrets buried at any cost.
